

## Peer Mentor Program at OWPS

We have 32 trained Peer Mentors at OWPS. Their role is to support children across all year groups to have successful, friendly and calm playtimes and lunchtimes.

Each Peer Mentor has completed 3 training sessions using training tools from The Anna Freud Institute. They wear rainbow coloured lanyards so that other people can recognise them and are timetabled to be 'on duty' during breaks across the school day.

Ongoing support for our Peer Mentors is provided via our school Learning Mentor team and our PSHE subject leader. Once training is complete the mentors have termly 'time to talk' catch up sessions with a member of the Learning Mentor team or the PSHE subject lead as well as having open drop in sessions at any time so that they can discuss any incident they have dealt with or seek advice or support.

Peer Mentors record their work in a record log which is checked regularly by our Learning Mentor team.
