Dear Parents/Carers of children in Year 4,

We are writing to you about two exciting events in Year 4 this term.

Firstly, Year 4 will be taking part in the 'We Will Perform' project with OBA. This project is a collaboration between the Year 4 children at OWPS and the Year 8 children at OBA. It requires the children to gain knowledge about Shakespeare, in particular, 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'. We will be exploring this through English, Art and Drama sessions with two interactive sessions agreed upon between the two schools. All of this will then be put into a fundraiser evening hosted at OBA in late June. It will be a great way for some of our children to showcase the brilliant work they will have completed.

Secondly, linked to the drama element of the project and live theatre, following our completion of this project, we have arranged for Year 4 to attend a performance of David Walliams' Gangsta Granny. This will be at the New Theatre Peterborough, on Friday 15th July, during the school day. Children will travel to the venue either by coach or taxi, accompanied by school staff.

A packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks please) will be needed. All children will also need to wear a school uniform.

The cost of the event is **£15.75** per child, which includes the travel costs and admission. The amount for this event will be taken from your child's annual trip fee of £30. However, if you have decided NOT to pay the annual trip fee and wish to pay for each event separately, the payment of **£15.75** must be paid by **Friday 20th May 2022 to secure the booking**. Please be aware that a trip/event will only take place when there is a commitment from at least 90% of parents to pay the full voluntary contribution.

Voluntary Contributions - It is important to note that no child is excluded from an activity simply because his or her parents are unwilling or unable to pay the voluntary contribution. If you are in receipt of Universal Credit, Income Support, Income Based Jobseekers Allowance, support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Child Tax Credit, provided that Working Tax Credit is not also received and the family's income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) does not exceed £16,190 then please arrange to see the Head teacher or the School.
