Objectives: Our sustainability policy aims to:

- Reduce the environmental impact of our activities and events by adopting sustainable practices and reducing our carbon footprint.
- Promote awareness of environmental issues and the importance of sustainability among children and adults.
- Promote social responsibility by supporting equality and communities in need.
- Ensure economic viability by pursuing sustainable practices that balance the needs of people, the planet, and profit.
- Continuously improve our sustainability performance.

Actions: To achieve these objectives, Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS) will:

- 1. Reduce Waste: We will minimize waste at all our events and where possible avoid single use plastics.
- Promote Recycling: We will promote recycling wherever possible and encouraging parents and children to recycle all paper, plastic, and glass waste as well school uniform and other items.
- 3. Reduce Energy Consumption: We will reduce our energy consumption by turning off all electrical appliances and lights when they are not in use.
- 4. Encourage Sustainable Transport: We will encourage parents and children to walk, cycle, or take public transport to school, events, and activities.



- 5. Promote Sustainable Food Choices: We will promote sustainable food choices our events and wherever possible use locally sourced, seasonal produce.
- 6. Education and Awareness: We will promote awareness of environmental issues and sustainability among children and adults by providing information on sustainable practices through our communication channels.
- 7. Continuous Improvement: We will regularly review our sustainability policy and performance to identify areas for improvement and to ensure that we are meeting our sustainability objectives.
