



Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS) Risk Management Policy

Introduction

This policy sets out the principles for risk management within Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS).

It is relevant to all within the association and is endorsed by the committee of Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS).

It will be reviewed at each AGM to ensure that it remains appropriate to the Organisation and its volunteers needs annually.

Purpose

The purpose of Risk Management is to identify risks as early as possible, develop a strategy to mitigate those risks and implement a risk management process as part of Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS) event planning process.

For all Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS) events:

- A Risk Assessment is to be conducted by a committee member to:
 - Identify potential hazards.
 - Identify who may be harmed by such hazards.
 - Determine whether existing precautions are adequate or whether further action needs to be taken.
 - Record your findings on the Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS) Risk Assessment template.
 - Review your assessment and update when necessary.

- Take advice from the school/venue where appropriate – look at previous risk assessments and adhere to recommendations.

- Take advice from the HSE where appropriate – www.hse.gov.uk

- A copy of the Risk Assessment to be kept in a designated folder for use by the Friends of Orton Wistow School (FOWS) – this can be used for reference if the same event is being run in the future.

- A copy of the Risk Assessment given to the school if requested.

- All committee members should be made aware of each risk assessment.

Changes to the policy

The Committee reserve the right to change this policy to maintain consistency with current best practice and the needs of the organisation. This policy will be reviewed annually by the Friends of Orton Wistow School committee at the AGM but may be amended at any time at the discretion of the current elected committee.
