**Red Nose Day- Friday 15th March.**

On Friday 15th March, OWPS will be supporting Comic Relief, by taking part in Red Nose Day activities to raise money for this charity. There are a number of ways in which we will be supporting the day, and children are invited to participate in as many as they wish.

Firstly, Friday 15th March will be a non-uniform day for children. All children are invited to wear non-school uniform and/or red clothing on this day. The school kitchen will also be baking special Red Nose Day biscuits for all children. We have an active School Council at OWPS, and this year, the School Council members have decided a new way for the school to raise money for this charity event. On Friday 15th, at breaktime, each class will organise and run a stall on the playground to raise money for Comic Relief. Classes have discussed their ideas, and details of the stalls can be found below. Children will be able to visit stalls on either playground, and breaktime will be extended to allow everyone to visit the stalls they would like to support.

To help the event run smoothly, all stalls will follow the format of 50p a go, or 3 goes for £1. Children are invited to bring a maximum of £3 to school to spend on the stalls- you might like to use the list below to help children decide in advance which they will visit. Children should bring any money in a named envelope or purse (which they are responsible for looking after). Any money must please be in change only- a combination of 50p and £1 coins would be ideal.
