The Mini Monsters road show works to high standards of health and safety and animal welfare, whilst promoting fascination with wildlife from around the world. Children will learn fascinating facts and be given the opportunity to meet and even handle a selection of minibeasts, reptiles and invertebrates.

Children will be given the opportunity to meet and even handle the animals if they chose to. Great emphasis is given to hygiene and children are required to thoroughly wash their hands after handling the animals.
