## Year 3 and 4 PHSE

As part of their learning in PSHE, Years 3 and 4 will be following a Healthy and Safer Lifestyles/Sex and Relationships unit.

Children will be taught to:

- name the main external parts of male and female bodies and will use some scientific names for these (for example penis, testicles, breast, vagina)
- explain which parts of the body are male and which are female.
- be able to give several examples of what their body can do and why they are unique.
- be able to describe familiar hygiene routines such as brushing teeth and washing hair, and understand the reasons for doing these things.
- be able to look forward to new areas of responsibility for their personal hygiene.
- be able to explain how common illnesses such as colds or tummy bugs are spread and be able to describe how they can prevent the spread of one such illness.


